The fixture is compatible with various metal and glass shade choices (see below).

INSTALLING LAMP & SHADE:


- 1. Install aiming wand by screwing clockwise into threaded hole in the rear of the fixture.
- 2. Place the lamp inside the shade so the two pins protrude through the back. Insert the lamp into the fixture by aligning the pins with the socket holes, and gently pushing until lamp seats.
- 3. Use an MR16-G (glass covered lamp) 50 watt
- 4. max (12 or 24 volt depending on power supply).
- Attach the shade by twisting and pushing in one continuous motion over the spring band.
 Note: May be used with 50W Xenon bi-pin lamp.


INSTALLING THE QUICK CONNECT:

- 1. Insert the post of the quick connect into the quick connect adapter.
- 2. Thread the top half of the conical section until it seats with the adapter.
- 3. Adjust fixture position, use caution not to loosen the conical section.
